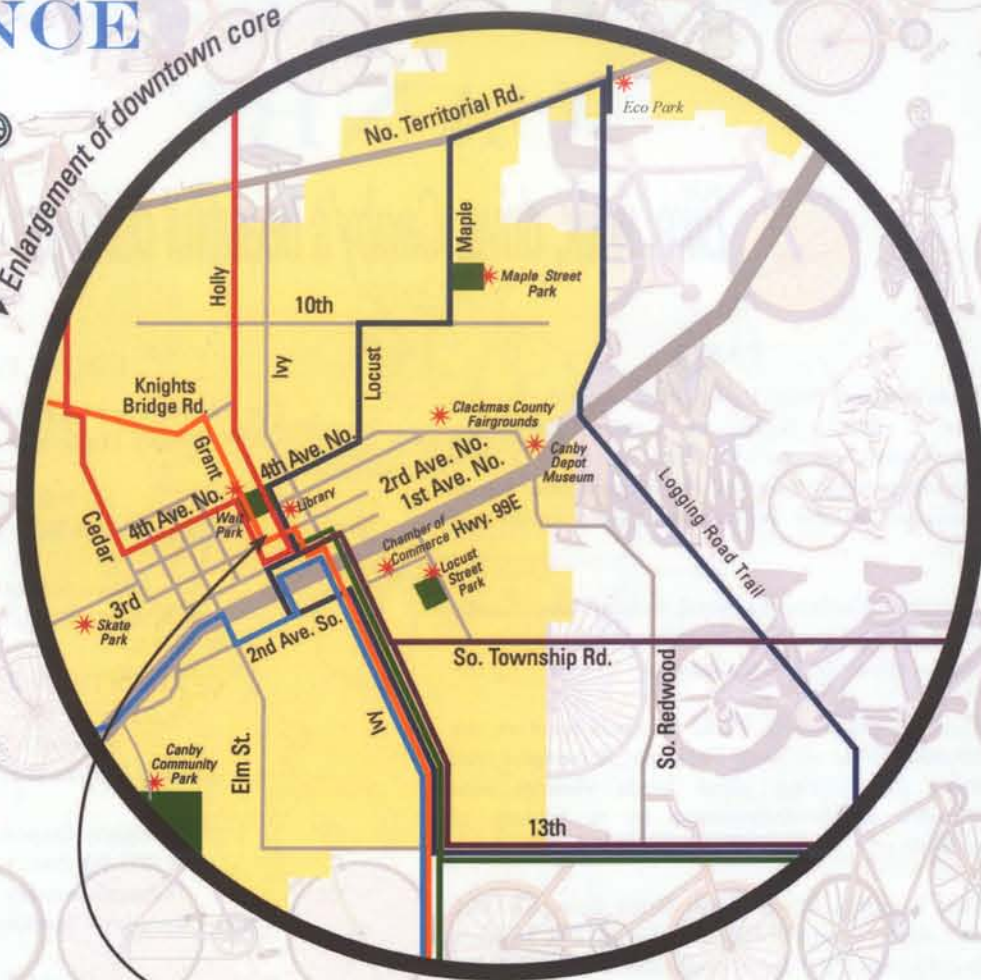

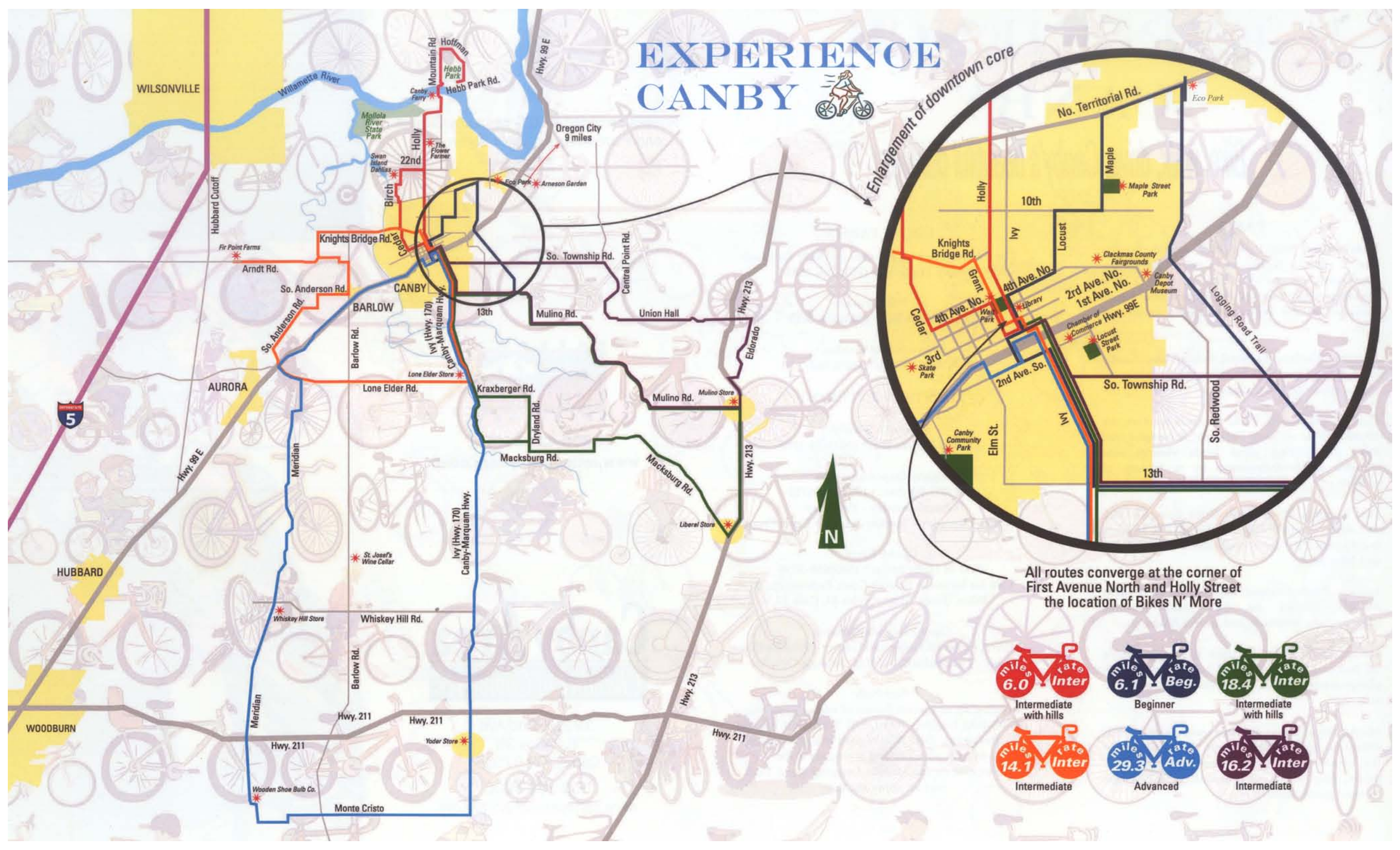


Enlargement of downtown core

PARKS

Molalla River State Park: This natural area sits just 2 miles North of Canby along the confluence of the Willamette, Molalla and Pudding rivers. One of the largest blue heron rookeries in the Willamette Valley is located here.

Arneson Garden: Located behind the Canby Fred Meyer store. An excellent opportunity to view a special Azalea garden.

Canby Community Park: Nestled next to the Molalla River off Berg Parkway. A wetland trail from the fishing pond leads visitors into wooded areas frequented by a variety of wildlife.

The Logging Road Trail: Runs from SE 13th Ave north to the Willamette River. The historic logging road has been converted into a walking and bike path.

Legacy Park: Located adjacent to Ackerman Middle School on SE 13th, features playgrounds, restroom and soccer fields.

Locust Street Park: Located halfway between SE 2nd and SE 4th Ave on S Locust Street, with playgrounds, restroom, benches, and a picnic area.

Maple Street Park: Located just north of NE 10th Ave. along Maple Street. Enjoy sitting in the bleachers to watch a baseball or softball game, play tennis or handball or utilize the covered picnic area.
